Metz is a proudly Australian owned company founded in 1953 and has been continuously operating for over 60 years.

Metz' ability to combine directly imported, purpose-made pool tiles from Europe with our own locally manufactured adhesive systems, and install them with our own labour force was unique back in the 1960s when we tiled our first pool. It is still unique today – there are no other companies able to offer such a single point of responsibility.

Our partnering supplier Interbau Blink is a German Company; this is an organisation that evolved from the amalgamation of two ceramics companies – both over 100 years old. The main focus on tile production began over 50 years ago. Around 30 years ago Blink were one of the first companies to invest in a horizontal extrusion line and subsequently are able to produce swimming pool tiles in all three main types of production, vertical extrusion, horizontal extrusion and dry pressed methods.

All three methods of production enable products to be produced with very low water absorption – typically around 0.5 to 1% which provides a good balance for frost and impact resistance, adhesion strength and minimal growth.

The company has been owned by a charitable foundation since 1989 and supports a number of activities including cancer research, which is appealing to all at Metz. Blink has supplied in excess of 500 pools representing square meterage figures in the millions.
